Khmer Ceramics workshop:

What you experiment?

You make one ceramic; using Khmer Traditional technique, by hand. You are guided by a potter usual to Khmer Traditional technique; you can even make Khmer traditional pots or let play your creativity. During the drying of your artifacts, we propose you a visit of our Khmer Ceramics Centre, guided by your teacher. We deliver your artifact, fired and glazed at your hotel-guesthouse in Siem Reap through 24 hours.

Duration:

2 hours.

Cost:

\$15.00 per person (1 pot per person; \$5.00 for each additional pot).

Including visit of the Khmer Ceramics Studio, teacher, firing and all raw material, no additional fees.

Maximum group size:

20 Pax.

Reservation :

No reservation needed, possibility to handle larger groups within 10 days reservation.



Potter wheel workshop:



What you experiment?

You make one ceramic artifact; on the potter wheel to feel potters sensations; using Khmer Traditional technique. You are guided by a potter usual to Khmer Traditional technique; you can even make Khmer traditional pots or let play your creativity. After 30 minutes using the potter wheel, we propose you a visit of our Khmer Ceramics Centre, guided by your teacher.

We deliver your artifact, fired and glazed to your hotel-guesthouse in Siem Reap in 24 hours.

Duration:

1 hour 30 minutes (30 minutes on the potter wheel).

Cost:

\$15.00 per person (1 pot per person; \$5.00 for each additional pot).

Including visit of the Khmer Ceramics Studio, teacher, firing and all raw material, no additional fees.

Maximum group size:

8 Pax.

Reservation : No reservation needed.



Khmer Raku workshop:

What you experiment?

You make one ceramic artifact; using Khmer Traditional technique, by hand. You are guided by a potter usual to Khmer Traditional technique; you can even make Khmer traditional pots or let play your creativity. During the drying of your artifacts, we propose you a visit of our Khmer Ceramics Centre, guided by your teacher. During the last hour, we glaze pots and fire it at 1000°C using Raku technique. We deliver your artifact, fired and glazed to your hotel-guesthouse in Siem Reap in 24 hours.



Duration:

3 hours.

Cost:

\$20.00 per person (1 pot per person; \$5.00 for each additional pot).

Including visit of the Khmer Ceramics Studio, teacher, firing and all raw material, no additional fees.

Maximum group size:

20 Pax.

Reservation :

No reservation needed; possibility to handle larger group within 10 days reservation.

Khmer ancient workshop:



What you experiment ?

You make your artifact; using Khmer Ancestral technique, with the potter wheel or by hand.

Two half-days workshops, using and learning ancient Khmer techniques. Making pots with the potters wheel, by coils, carvings and modeling. Glazing with ancient Khmer glaze made by you. **Pieces are available 2 weeks after the workshop.**

Duration :

6 hours (3 hours 2 times); extra hours

can be made on request, please specify when you make reservation.

Cost :

150\$ per person, teacher, firing and all raw material. If you want to send your works, parcel fee are paid by you.

Maximum group size:

20 Pax.

ceramics processing including drying and firing can't be completed by individual, engaging Social responsibility of attendees. The use of clay encourages self-discovery and adds to sensory stimulation. It can be an outlet for frustration and improves motor skills.
